UCI Emergency CLASSROOM EMERGENCY PROCEDURES



SECURE-IN-PLACE

(police related activity/active shooter)



WHEN NOTIFIED BY:

zotALERT

Emergency personnel Zone Crew members NOTIFY class of "Secure-In-Place" order

LOCK or barricade doors

TURN OFF lights and close blinds

SILENCE cell phones

MOVE away from doors and windows

USE furniture to provide added protection and barricades

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS given by emergency personnel

DO NOT leave until directed to do so

EVACUATION



EVACUATE WHEN:

There is a fire Fire alarm activates lotified by emergency personne NOTIFY class of evacuation and assembly area

KEEP calm

WALK quickly to the nearest exit

DO NOT use elevators

ASSIST persons with disabilities, access or functional needs

MOVE to your designated assembly area

KEEP streets and walkways clear for emergency personnel

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS given by emergency personnel

DO NOT return to the building until directed to do so

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS | WHAT STUDENTS NEED TO KNOW TIPS FROM UC IRVINE EMERGENCY SERVICES

Call 9-1-1 immediately if you have an emergency or see something suspicious on campus.

- Sign up for UCI zotALERTS to receive timely text messages about campus emergencies and safety-related information: http://www.oit.uci.edu/zotalert
- If you are in class and a zotALERT is issued, notify your Professor/Teaching Assistant immediately.
- Program your phone with the UCI Emergency Information number to access updates during an emergency: 866-IRV-NEWS (866-478.6397).

EVACUATIONS: IS IT A DRILL OR IS IT REAL?

In either event, here's what you do:

- Take every evacuation order seriously.
- . Take your personal belongings, and immediately go to the designated assembly area.
- · Remain in the assembly area until you receive further instructions.

EARTHQUAKE

- DROP, COVER, and HOLD ON Immediately seek shelter (under a desk or table, if possible), cover your head, and hold on to something stardy.
- Stay away from windows, filing cabinets, and wall-mounted cabinetry.
- Assess your surroundings, and evacuate only if necessary or when directed to do so.

FIRE

- If you see smoke or flames inside the building, get out quickly.
- If the fire alarm is not audible, and you can do so safely, pull the alarm as you leave the building.
- Call 9-1-1 as soon as it is safe to do so.
- Go to the appropriate assembly area.
- . Do not re-enter the building until emergency responders have given the go-ahead.

SECURE IN PLACE (POLICE-RELATED ACTIVITY)

- REMAIN CALM
- IF INSIDE:
 - ✓ Find an interior room, if possible.
 - √ Lock/barricade the door. Move/use furniture for added protection.
 - ✓ Turn off lights and draw blinds.
 - ✓ Stay quiet, and silence your cell phone.
 - ✓ Stay in place until an all-clear message is received.
- IF OUTSIDE:
- ✓ Seek shelter in a nearby building.
- If unable to get inside, seek nearby shelter behind large trees, walls, cars in parking lot/garage, away from the danger area (if known).
- √ Stay sheltered until an all-clear message is received.



ZONE CREW STRUCTURE








A fire and/or life safety emergency occurs



BE READY TO ACT WITHOUT ELECTRICITY OR LIGHTS



IF YOU MUST LEAVE A BUILDING, USE EXTREME CAUTION AND WATCH FOR FALLING DEBRIS






Use telephones ONLY to report life-threatening emergencies, lines will be jammed

Check social media pages for updates









